We begin our 2010 program of tours with a Barn and house tour in Buskirk, northern Rensselaer County, on Saturday, May 8.

Saturday, May 8. Meet at Tom Lanni's, 206 Schweninger Road, Buskirk, NY 12028. Schweninger road is off County 114, Master Street, in the northernmost part of Rensselaer County, just north of the Hoosick River.

This is a barn preservation success story- the DBPS visited this barn, the former Gremps/Fredericks Barn from Stone Arabia, in 1999, and featured it in the Fall 1999 newsletter. It has been moved and Tom is putting it back up.



We will then visit the Andritz barn along route 67 which has some Dutch elements, and then we will go to several historic buildings restored by the Persistence foundation, located at 59 Sherman Lane, off Nickmush Road, Buskirk 12028.





Here we will see an early Dutch house, and two early timber framed barns-one preserved as a historic barn, the other adaptively reused for the Foundation. There is also an early corn crib at the site. The Foundation has a website with excellent descriptions and photos of the buildings, as
